Programme

The same format as last year, with the Downhill (including pre-race speed runs) early Friday morning, followed by the Slalom and cocktail function on mountain. There may be a little something in between the two events – watch this space! GS as usual on Saturday, followed by the awards dinner party at Arrowtown

Training

Acknowledging the pressure on lane space at Rocky Gully (remember last year), we have a much better arrangement. There will be both a Slalom and GS course set up which remain in place throughout Wednesday afternoon. This is primarily designed for you to run gates and get some kms under the skis. On Thursday afternoon from 11.30am to 2.30pm, Nils Coberger will run a GS clinic as a fund raiser for the National Team, who will be in attendance. It will consist of 3 hours GS training with video.
